

DESCRIPTION

- 1. Ensure mains are switched off.
- 2. Separate the fixing plate (A) from the cover plate (B) by loosening fixing ring's (C) and fixing nut (D).
- 3. You will need to also unscrew O rings (E) to remove the cover.
- 4. Install fixing plate (A) to ceiling.
- 5. Make sure there is enough fixing in the ceiling to suitably support the total weight of the fitting. (Max 18kg).
- 6. Slide cover plate (B) bock onto rods then slide fixing rings (C) onto rod then screw the O rings (E) back onto the rods.
- 7. Remove all Rods (F) from packaging and determine total drop required. This will be in increments of 250mm.
- 8. Screw rods together and feed power cable through one side. Do not cut power cable length at this stage.
- 9. Screw mounting hooks (G) onto the top of the rods.
- 10. Feed the power cable from the fixture into the hole (H) on the cover plate (B).
- 11. The fitting will now hang freely allowing you to make final electrical connection.
- 12. Finish off installation by lifting cover plate and sliding in place.
- 13. Secure cover plate with fixing nut (D) and by tightening fixing rings (C) in place.
- 14. Remove glass protective cover (J) and put in appropriate globes.
