



DESCRIPTION

1. Ensure mains are switched off.
2. Separate the wall fixing plate (A) from the main fitting (B) by unscrewing the fastening screw (C) at the bottom of the light fitting.
3. Do not remove the protective cover from the light fitting yet (D).
4. Use the fixing plate (A) to form a template for the fixing holes on the wall.
5. Make sure there is enough fixing on the wall to suitably support the weight of the light fitting (5kgs).
6. Mount fixing plate (A) onto the wall.
7. There is an exit and entry hole (E) on the fixing plate (A) if required.
8. Bring mains cable (F) through the fixing plate holes (E) and connect mains wires using the connector block provided (G).
9. Refit the main fitting (B) onto the wall fixing plate (A) by sliding the main fitting onto the top lip (H) of the wall fixing plate (A).
10. Now that the main fitting (B) is supported by the fixing bracket (A), you can fasten the bottom screw (C) to secure the wall light.
11. Remove the protective cover (D) from the light fitting
12. Install appropriate lamps (light bulbs) - take note of the recommended wattage.
